Call to order

Financial Management

4. How have you created and implemented innovative financial management? How have you handled making difficult decisions that may not be popular on campus?

Academic Planning & Enrollment Management

- 5. How would you prioritize academic innovation and embrace shared governance with faculty? *Follow up question if needed.*
- 6. How have you improved Student Success at your institution while being adaptable and responsive to emerging trends?

Students

7. How do you interact with students and encourage student engagement?

Diversity and Inclusion

8. How have you addressed diversity and inclusion within your organization in structurally significant ways that improve a sense of belonging and cohesion on campus? Add follow up if necessary. Want to be sure they address students, staff and faculty.

Faculty and Staff

9. What are the key elements that create a positive work environment and how would you address faculty and staff experiencing professional fatigue?

External Engagement

- 10. It is essential for a president to collaborate with a variety of stakeholders, including the MA Public Higher Education system and community organizations. Please describe a partnership you developed with an external stakeholder that was mutually beneficial. What led you to develop this relationship and what were the outcomes?
- 11. Fundraising, development and alumni engagement will be major tasks for the next president. Please share your experience in philanthropy with specific examples of donor cultivation and successful solicitations.

It was also decided to move the student question to #7. Once the list has been finalized, the final copy will be sent to the committee.

Mr. Gregoire briefly explained that he will ask the first question and move around the table so committee members can also ask questions. The order of the questions will be reversed for each candidate so that every committee member is able to ask questions.
