Liberal Arts & Sciences

Arts and Humanities, including Literature and Foreign Languages: 15 credits

Of the 48 required credits at least five courses must be in the Arts Cluster ("ART"), two must fulfill the writing I and II requirement, one must be an art or music course (AOM), and one must be a literature course (LIT)

Recommended:

- ENGL 1100: Writing I 3 cr.
- ENGL 1200: Writing II. 3cr.
- MUSIC 2000, 2100, 2120,2130 or 2210: Commonwealth of the Art Course, ENGL 2300 or 2900 3cr.
- ENGL 2900 Children's Lit 3 cr.
- ART Elective 3 cr.

Mathematics and the Natural and Physical Sciences: 15 credits

Of the 48 required credits at least four courses must be in the Science, Math and Technology Cluster ("SMT"), one must be a math, one must be a lab science, and one must fulfill the health and fitness requirement.

Recommended:

- MATH 1100 Mathematics in Society 3 cr.
- Lab Science 3cr.
- EXSS 1000 or 2060: Health Fitness or Exercise, Nutrition, and Heart Disease 3cr.
- PSY 2010 Child Development 3cr.
- SMT Elective

Social Sciences: 9 credits

Of the 48 required credits at least three courses must be in the Citizenship and the World Cluster ("CTW"), one must be a human behavior course, and one must be a history course ("HIST").

Recommended:

- PSY 1200: Lifespan Development 3cr.
- HIST 1000 or 1100 World Civ. I/II 3cr.
- HIST 1400 or 1500: US History I/II 3 cr.

Global Diversity: (Already Counted Above)

Of the 48 required credits, at least two courses must be in Global Diversity in at least two clusters. At least one of these courses must address a non-western region or culture.

These attributes are met through the recommended courses listed above:

- HIST 1000 or 1100: World Civ. I/II,
- MUSIC 2000, 2100, 2120,2130 or 2210: Commonwealth of the Art Course
