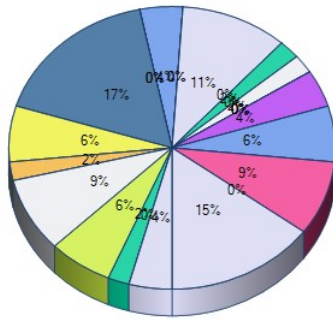

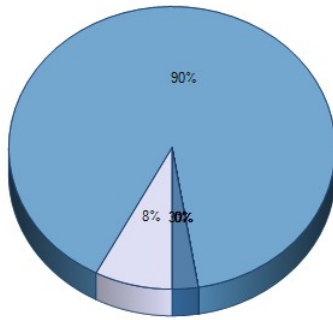

 2. The experience of FSU from a commuter perspective- limited social engagement and peer interaction
When I started at Fitchburg State I was a 24 year old being in a community college for 6 years. Fitchburg State was my dream school since high school, and only college I applied to as a transfer student. I came for the film/video program (was one of five students into the program that incoming semester) I was a tour guide and WXPL radio president for a year each. I wish I could of done more but I was limited to as my untreatable ADHD due to extensive High Blood Pressure impaired my reading capabilities and concentration in school work. I now am in the midst of my synthesis and graduating with my masters at UMass Boston in eagerness to be a career/success coach.

I think what could help future students is the school getting more involved in having places that hold internships every semester and connections in the field for students to get started after graduation. Better transitions from graduation to a few different career paths within a field.

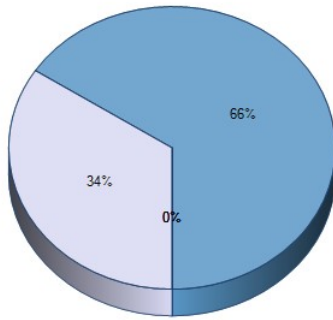

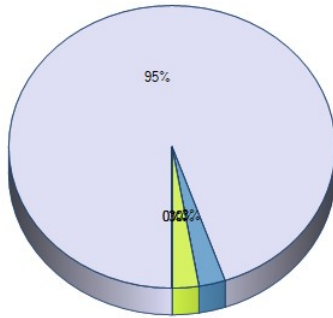

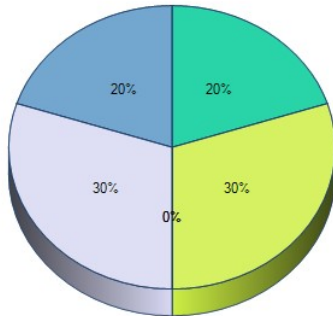
