ACTION ITEMS

Clearance for Graduation and Confirmation of Attendance

To confirm that you have been cleared to participate in graduation, as well as to verify your ceremony attendance status, please log into your MyFalcon account at **myfalcon.fitchburgstate.edu**. Click on **View Application to Graduate**. If, while your file is being reviewed for graduation, the Registrar finds that you meet requirements for participating in the ceremony, you will be invited to attend the ceremony.

It is essential that we know the exact number of students attending the ceremony. If you will not be able to attend, please contact the Registrar's Office by **Friday**, **December 6** at **978-665-4196** or **registrar@fitchburgstate.edu**.

■ Important Reminders

If you took courses at another university, transcripts from that university must be received in the Registrar's Office by **Friday, January 3**. Grades for incompletes must also be in by January 3.

Caps and Gowns

Caps and gowns will be available for purchase through the bookstore in Hammond Hall and online at **fitchburgstateshop.com**. The cost for the entire package is \$60 for bachelor's, \$65 for master's and \$67 for CAGS. The sleeves of the gown indicate the degree the individual has completed. The bachelor's degree has long, pointed sleeves, while the master's has oblong sleeves, open at the wrist, with the front part cut in an arc. The hood distinguishes the institution from which the wearer is graduating and the degree being awarded. Graduates and Guests with Disabilities

Graduates and guests who have a disability can request accommodations through the Disability Services Office. CEREMONY INFORMATION

■ Commencement Ceremony Schedule

Commencement is scheduled for **Friday**, **December 20 at 4 PM**. There is no rehearsal. **Please arrive at the Athletics and Recreation Center no later than 3 PM**. Volunteers will be available to assist you. The ceremony will be approximately two hours long.

The guests' seating area will open at 2:30 PM. Graduates will be lined up alphabetically within their division and major. Your name will be read as you cross the stage to receive your diploma cover from President Hodge. You will be given an index card on which your name has been typed. If you have a name that is difficult to pronounce, please provide the phonetic spelling. Please do

not lose this card! When you approach the platform, this card will be handed to the reader. The chair of your program will lead the graduates on stage and present them to the president and the chairman of the Board of Trustees. Please return to your seat promptly upon exiting the stage.

Parking

Directions to the campus and designated parking lots for the ceremony can be found at **fitchburgstate.edu/commencement**.

Shuttle buses will be in operation between the Intermodal Center and the McKay Front parking lot, making its regular stops along North Street and the Athletics and Recreation Center.

Photographs

During the ceremony, access to the stage area for picture-taking or videotaping by guests will be prohibited. Please relay this information to your guests. A professional photograph will be taken as you receive your diploma cover and congratulations from the President, and you will receive a digital copy of the photograph courtesy of the Fitchburg State University Alumni Association.

Diplomas

All diplomas will be mailed to graduates in January 2025 to be placed in the diploma cover you will receive at the ceremony. Your name will be engraved on your diploma as you indicate on your commencement application. Care is taken to accurately produce your diploma. In the event that we make a mistake, promptly contact the Registrar's Office and a corrected diploma will be issued.



ACADEMIC HONORS

Undergraduates

Academic honors are awarded to undergraduates based on a minimum of 45 semester hours of courses taken at Fitchburg State University.

Cum Laude – 3.2+ GPA | Magna Cum Laude – 3.5+ GPA | Summa Cum Laude – 3.8+ GPA

Honors designation in the commencement program will be based upon the student's cumulative grade point average at the time of program production. All undergraduate students who are eligible for honors will receive honors medallions to wear with their commencement robes. Students graduating with honors will be given their medallions at the ceremony check-in table the night of the ceremony.

Final honors status will be determined by the Registrar and will be identified on your final transcript and diploma.



Transfer students with a minimum of 30 semester hours of courses taken at Fitchburg State University will be eligible for academic honors as calculated by the Registrar's Office, taking into account their GPA from previous institutions.

Students completing their graduation requirements in the Fitchburg State University Honors Program will have their thesis listed in the commencement program.
