GCE-22-23-2 - GCE Graduate Course Removal – MGMT 9030 – Accounting Theory

MGMT 9030 Accounting Theory a theory-driven course, currently serves as a substitute course for the required Accounting course requirement MGMT 9180 a quantitative course Accounting Practices for Managers. Having one course as the requirement provides a more reliable basis for enhancing and improving student performance and readiness for preparing Financial Statements which is a requirement for MGMT 9170- Corporate Finance, the single finance requirement in the program.

GCE-22-23-3 - GCE Graduate Program Change – MGMT 9030

This proposal removes a substitute accounting core course MGMT 9030- Accounting Theory and requires a single core course, MGMT 9180 to serve as the requirement for all MBA concentrations.

Students taking this course will benefit from basic accounting practice including the preparation of financial statements, which are not included in MGMT 9030 a theory-driven course but required in MGMT 9170 Corporate Finance.
